RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS - THE OVAL, LONDON - CRICKET WORLD CUP 2019 MAY/JUNE 2019

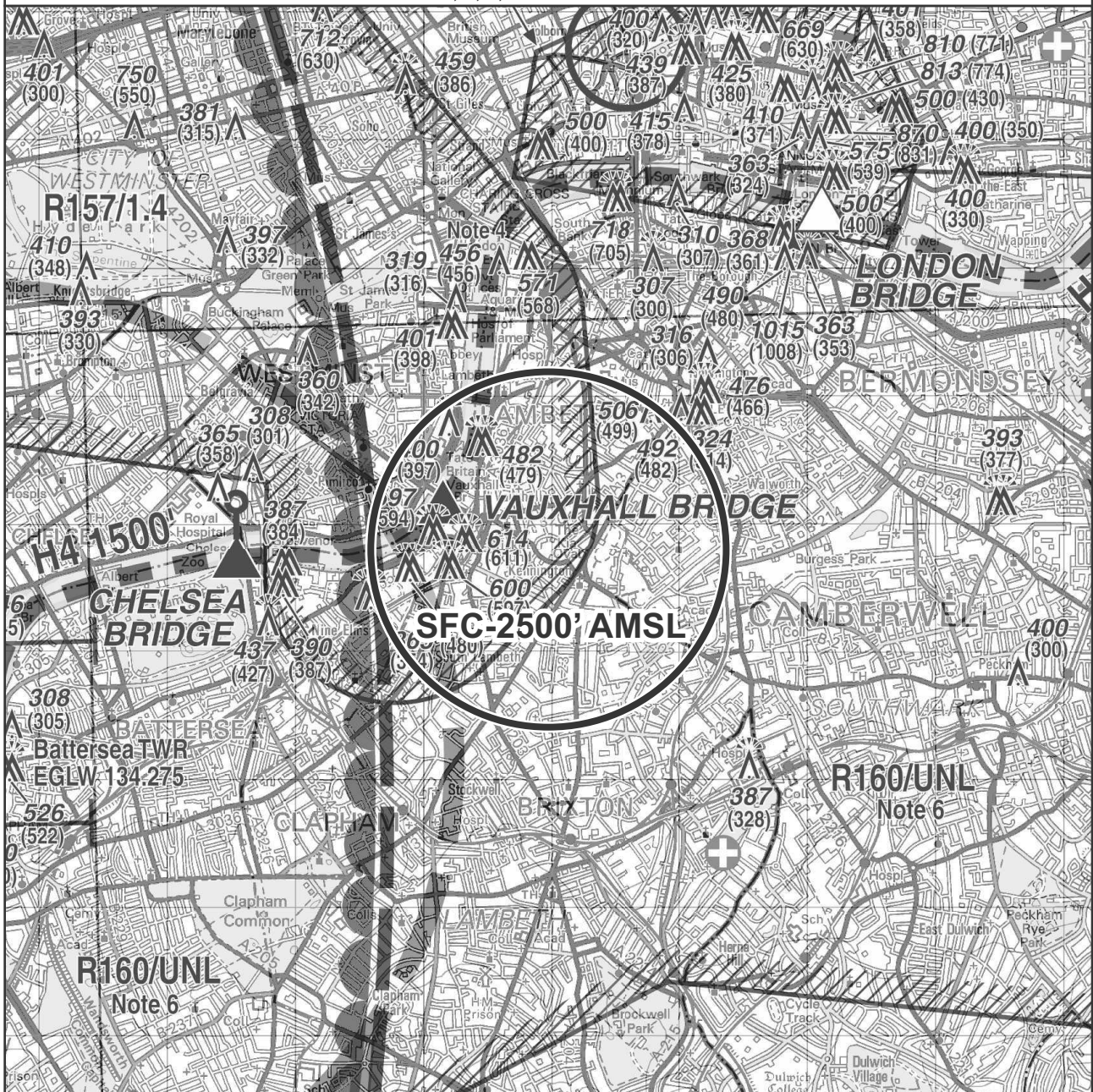
- 1** The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict the flying of unmanned aircraft in the vicinity of The Oval cricket ground, London by reason of the intended gathering of large numbers of persons attending the 2019 Cricket World Cup matches which are to be held there on certain dates between **25 May and 15 June 2019**.
- 2** Restriction of Flying Regulations are established under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016 to restrict the operation of all types of unmanned aircraft on the grounds of safety and security.
THESE RESTRICTIONS OF FLYING DO NOT APPLY TO MANNED AIRCRAFT
- 3** Subject to paragraph 5, and during the periods stated in paragraph 4, no unmanned aircraft system is to fly below 2,500 FT AMSL within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 0.75 NM whose centre is at 512902N 0000654W.
- 4** The restrictions stated in paragraph 3 are valid between **0500 hours and 2000 hours** on each of the following dates:
 - a) 25 May 2019;
 - b) 27 May 2019;
 - c) 30 May 2019;
 - d) 2 June 2019;
 - e) 5 June 2019;
 - f) 9 June 2019; and
 - g) 15 June 2019.
- 5** Paragraph 3 does not apply to any unmanned aircraft system operating with the permission of Chief Inspector Phil Palmer of the Metropolitan Police Service who may be contacted on telephone number 07785-451515.
- 6** In relation to paragraphs 3 and 5, the term 'unmanned aircraft' by virtue of Article 23 of the Air Navigation Order 2016 includes any small unmanned aircraft.
- 7** The times mentioned in this Circular are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time.
