


Context of ARPAS-UK




Context of ARPAS-UK

The top 5 ARPAS Member industry sectors, taken from the 2016 ARPAS membership survey, are:

- 65% Building and Structures Inspection
- 62% Other Aerial Photography / Video
- 46% Land Surveying / Mapping
- 44% TV & Movie Filming
- 28% Distributed Infrastructure Inspection (e.g. pipelines)
- Not just the single operator, larger well funded businesses.










Business Plan Priority Areas 2017

- Membership Benefits










Business - Standards 2017

- Standard for NQE Activity? broad spectrum of "Training" and variation of PfCO courses. The Concept of an "ARPAS Academy" being discussed.
- Standard for PfCO? entry level members are keen to enhance knowledge and set themselves apart from the leisure / non commercial operator.
- Standard for specific industry? how to operate in sectors such as , Survey / Inspection etc
- Linked closely with CPD and Education.
- Industry Professionals looking for answers, joint solution envisaged.










Standards - Where We are 2017

- Initial Discussions with NQEs started, those approached positive.
- BSI committee ACE/1/-/2Unmanned Aircraft Systems – what is planned, can work be combined?
- Some industries have already published a standard already - Oil and Gas UK UAS Operation Management Standards Guidelines.
- Industry input as to what is required from operators for various sectors -, Energy, construction, Close proximity work etc etc










Standards - Where are we Going 2017?
